Day 4 and the finale of Halloweek had SAC's physical photo booths and challenges entertaining residents throughout the night.


SAC x EXA hopes CAPTains enjoyed the event, and bids you a frightful farewell until next AY.

community engagement projects.


The guidebook features a collection of processes, reflections and templates provided by the authors who have had years of experience in this field.


